RESOLUTION #4A-02-02-21-06

**Requesting Installation of Speed Humps on Colorado Avenue NW West of
17th Street NW**

Adopted February 2, 2021

WHEREAS, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4A takes note of the following:

- Commissioner Pavan Khoobchandani, ANC 4A08, has received numerous requests for traffic calming and the installation of speed humps on Colorado Avenue NW west of 17th Street NW to the end of the road, because of speeding drivers.
- The Rock Creek East II Livability Study recommended traffic calming in the form of lane narrowing in this area of Colorado Avenue NW; however, such work has not been completed and would not resolve the speeding issues fully.
- The affected portion of Colorado Avenue NW is entirely residential, has “Local Traffic Only” signage installed, and end in a cul-de-sac.
- Speed hump installation is supported by well over 50% of the neighbors that live on this portion of Colorado Avenue NW.
- Current and planned traffic control measures, including posted speed limit and the aforementioned “Local Traffic Only” signs, have been insufficient to control speeding drivers.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4A requests that the District Department of Transportation install speed humps on the 4200-4500 block of Colorado Avenue NW, the 4600 block of Colorado Avenue NW, and the 4700 block of Colorado Avenue NW; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Advisory Neighborhood Commission requests that the District Department of Transportation implement the final recommendations for traffic calming on this portion of Colorado Avenue NW from the Rock Creek East II Livability Study; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Commission hereby designates Commissioner Pavan Khoobchandani, ANC 4A08 to serve as the Commission's representative in all matters relating to this resolution.

ADOPTED by voice/show of hands vote at a regularly scheduled public meeting (notice of which was properly given, and at which a quorum of seven of eight members was present) on February 2, 2021, by a vote of 7 yes, 0 no, and zero abstentions.
