ANC 4A Resolution 19100106 at October 1, 2019 ANC 4A Meeting

ANC 4A received notification on Monday, September 30, 2019 at 3:25 PM, via email, that the DC Department of Transportation (DDOT) has released the 2020 Terms and Conditions for the Shared Dockless Vehicle Program for our consideration. We were also notified that the comments will be received until Monday, October 7, 2019.

The 2020 permit will increase the total number of permitted dockless scooters from the current permitted number of 6,210 to a total of up to 10,000 devices. This also permits the use of rentals in the public space (including sidewalks, and the streets). We believe that this is a matter that needs to be considered and vetted by a number of agencies and through the Office of the Attorney General to ensure that this is legally permissible. It is unclear whether this is a change in the use of the public rights of way and we are not aware that this has gone through the process for allowing anything to be left on public space, especially for commercial purposes.

Because this is insufficient notice for the ANC 4A to consider such an important matter, we object to the request and ask that the ANC 4A be allowed 45 days from the date of issuance of the notice to consider the document and offer appropriate comments.

RESOLVED that ANC 4A opposes the short notice and requests 45 days for the ANC 4A to consider the document and provide our formal comments.

FURTHER RESOLVED that the ANC 4A Chair be the designated representative of the 4A ANC for this matter.
