Dear Mr. Carter:

Please be advised that the Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 4A, voted to oppose the issuance of a new Retail-Class "C" Tavern license for Qategna, Inc. (Applicant) at a special scheduled public meeting on July 13, 2021. The vote was 7 ayes, 0 nays and 0 abstentions.

Prior to the public meeting, ANC 4A issued notice to the applicant and to the public. The contact for the Applicant, Beniyam Woldeamanuel, has not responded to several requests to engage and sign a voluntary settlement agreement. The protest of this application is based on the following:

- (a) ongoing concerns about the over concentration of ABC licensed establishments on and near Georgia Avenue NW;
- (b) the granting of the requested liquor license to the establishment will have adverse impacts on the peace, order quiet and quality of life in the neighborhood, including but not limited to, public intoxication, increase littering, and increased loitering. The establishment is located near many residential homes. There is concern that if a license is granted, the qualify of life of residents will be severely impacted by increased noise, particularly in the evening and late night hours, and by an upsurge in litter along the 1200 block of Tuckerman Street NW and the adjacent and nearby blocks;
- (c) The planned Tavern will be located in an area where parking is very limited in the evenings. The opening of this new establishment with the requested liquor license will only exacerbate the parking difficulties and could cause an increase in vehicular traffic putting pedestrian safety at an increased level of risk; and
- (d) the potential adverse impact on the economic development and property values of the homes near the establishment.

Please file this protest with the official record of this case. ANC 4A Commission designated Commissioner Patience Singleton, SMD 4A04, to present the ANC's position and protest at the public hearing conducted by the ABC Board.
