RESOLUTION #4A-07-13-21-01

Requesting Installation of Speed Humps on 18th Street NW, Quincy Street NW, and Argyle Terrace NW in Crestwood

Adopted July 13, 2021

WHEREAS, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4A takes note of the following:

- Commissioner Pavan Khoobchandani, ANC 4A08, has received numerous requests for traffic calming and the installation of speed humps on 18th Street NW, Quincy Street NW, and Argyle Terrace NW, south of Shepherd St. NW in Crestwood, because of speeding drivers.
- The affected streets are entirely residential and constitute a loop such that there should be minimal, if any, through traffic. However, delivery drivers and others routinely drive through this area at unsafe speeds.
- Speed hump installation is supported by well over 50% of the neighbors that live on the affected streets.
- Current traffic control measures including the posted speed limit have been insufficient to control speeding drivers.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4A requests that the District Department of Transportation install speed humps on the 3800-3900 block of 18th Street NW, the 1800 block of Quincy St. NW, and the 3800-3900 block of Argyle Terrace NW; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Commission hereby designates Commissioner Pavan Khoobchandani, ANC 4A08 to serve as the Commission's representative in all matters relating to this resolution.

ADOPTED by voice/show of hands vote at a regularly scheduled public meeting (notice of which was properly given, and at which a quorum of seven of eight members was present) on July 13, 2021, by a vote of 7 yes, 0 no, and 0 abstentions.
