



# Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4A Government of the District of Columbia

## **RESOLUTION #4A-09-09-21-01**

**Requesting Installation of Speed Humps on the  
1600 Block of Allison St NW in Crestwood**

**Adopted September 7, 2021**

**WHEREAS**, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4A takes note of the following:

- A majority of the neighbors living on the 1600 block of Allison St. NW have signed a petition expressing their interest in having speed humps installed on their block because of speeding drivers.
- Many drivers use Allison St. NW in Crestwood travelling west to get to Blagden Avenue NW and Beach Drive NW because there are no speed humps, and travel in excess of the speed limit. Conversely, many drivers travelling east on Allison St. NW in Crestwood speed up in order to avoid stopping at the red light at the intersection of 16<sup>th</sup> Street NW and Allison St. NW.
- Speed hump installation is supported by well over 50% of the neighbors that live on the affected streets.
- The DDOT Service Request Number for this issue is 21-00388816.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4A requests that the District Department of Transportation install speed humps on the 1600 block of Allison St. NW; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Commission hereby designates Commissioner Pavan Khoobchandani, ANC 4A08 to serve as the Commission's representative in all matters relating to this resolution.

**ADOPTED** by voice/show of hands vote at a regularly scheduled public meeting (notice of which was properly given, and at which a quorum of seven of eight members was present) on September 9, 2021, by a vote of 6 yes, 0 no, and 0 abstentions.
